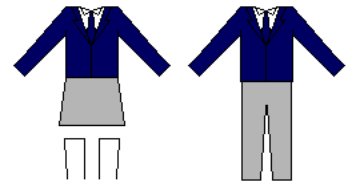

All children need to have PE kit in school made up of dark shorts, white t-shirt (or navy version with school logo – available from school for £4.50) and plimsolls.

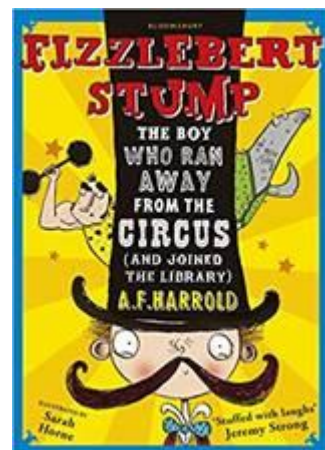
**Water Bottles** – available from school for £1.20
